

ABYC Dinghy Co-Operative Sailing Program Registration Form – 2017

Application for the Dinghy Co-Operative Sailing Program (DCSP) is **in addition to** valid and current membership at ABYC in any category other than "Out Of Town" or "Honorary". Participation in the DCSP does not include ABYC membership.

- Join one of Toronto's friendliest clubs, mix with Keelboat and Dinghy sailors
- Full use of ABYC facilities, restaurant and bar open year round, Bar-b-ques, patios, workshop, dinghy dock change room, gas dock change rooms and washrooms.
- Join in the social scene events, parties, regattas & Wednesday night dinghy races
- Unrestricted use of club owned fleet of Lasers
- First come first serve on booking dinghy anytime during day or weekend April to October.
- Join in our Keelboat club racing and crew bank for Tuesday & Thursday races.
- Learn boat maintenance, fiberglass repairs from experienced sailors
- Inexpensive way to sail before purchasing your own boat and membership
- Ratio of boats to members not to exceed 3:1
- ABYC covers cost of insurance, parts and replacement for normal wear and tear

Required Sailing Accreditation

Certificate of completion of White Sail 111 dinghy sailing program from any accredited CYA course or equivalent experience is required to join this program

- Sailing Lessons from ABYC dinghy school may be taken to obtain White Sail 111 Accreditation
- Applicants already holding a White Sail 111 certificate must provide a copy with this application and may be required to be checked out by our sailing school instructor at a \$50 cost of an hourly lesson.
- Applicants who have sailing experience must provide their sailing resume with this application and may be required to be checked out by our sailing school instructor at a \$50 cost of an hourly lesson.

Guidelines

ABYC is a self help club which depends on volunteers to maintain the club facilities and dinghies. DCSP members are required to participate in the launch, haul-out and maintenance of the dinghy club fleet.

- Must be 16 years old or over
- Check out bulletin board is provided to indicate boats sailed
- Bring own life jacket
- Check weather conditions before sailing . It is your responsibility to sail only in conditions of safety.
- Report, log at end of sail for deficiencies on the boat needing to be fixed. Significant damage to a boat is the members responsibility and may result in a damage charge to the deductible limit of insurance.
- Boat must leave dock with all legal safety equipment
