7 THE COURSES

7.1 Only the course shown in this supplement will be used for the event and as such no course designation will be posted; no later than the warning signal, the race committee will display the approximate compass bearing and distance of the first leg.

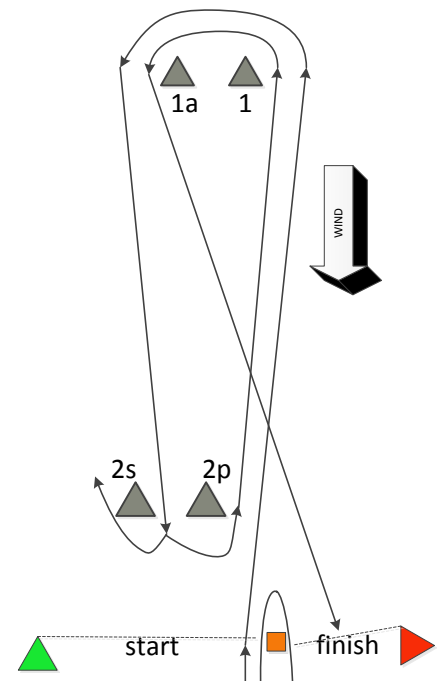
7.3 Rounding order: Start – 1 (port) – 1a (port) – 2s/2p (gate) – 1 (port) – 1a (port) – Finish

7.4 If mark 1a is not present it will be omitted from the rounding order.

7.5 If either of mark 2s/2p are missing, the remaining mark will be rounded to port.

7.6 Race Area locations and Radio Channels:

9 THE START

9.3 Initial Starting Sequence:

| Race Area | Fleet | Starting Sequence |

9.4 Starting sequence in the second and subsequent race of each day may vary.

9.5 Starts may be combined at the discretion of the Race Committee.

9.6 The Race Committee may announce the sail number or boat name of each premature starter on the applicable VHF channel. Failure to make an announcement or the order in which boats are announced shall not be grounds for redress. This changes Rule 62.1 (a).

12 TIME LIMITS

12.4 Boats failing to start within the Start window will be scored DNS. This changes Rule A5.

12.5 Limits:

14 SCORING

Is as described in the Notice of Race, except that the J105 fleet will have NO excluded races regardless of the number of races sailed.

15 SAFETY

15.1 Boats shall check in with the race committee prior to their first race of the day by sailing past the transom of the committee boat.

15.2 Boats shall advise the race committee, by radio or by hail, if leaving the race area prior to the end of the last race of the day.
